

2025 Nanjing Agricultural University Sino-Lao Modern Agricultural Industry Chain High-Caliber Talent Cultivation Program

(For Outstanding Lao Students and Scholars)

I. Scholarship Program Overview

To deepen the strategic collaboration between China and Laos in agricultural technology and support the modernization and sustainable development of Laos' agriculture, Sanya Institute of Nanjing Agricultural University, relying on the scientific research advantages of China's "Nanfan Silicon Valley," has established the "**Sino-Lao Modern Agricultural Industry Chain High-Caliber Talent Cultivation Program**". This program targets outstanding Lao students and scholars, focusing on core technologies across the entire agricultural industry chain. It aims to recruit and cultivate high-level talent in relevant agricultural disciplines, enhancing their research capabilities and practical skills.

Successful candidates will receive full scholarship funding and, beginning in September 2025, sequentially undertake studies and research at Nanjing Agricultural University and Sanya Yazhou Bay Science and Technology City, a leading agricultural innovation hub in China. The master's program spans three years; the doctoral program spans four years. The program emphasizes innovation, practical skills, and global perspectives, providing intellectual support for Laos' agricultural industry upgrade and fostering bilateral agricultural cooperation.

II. Program requirements and Duration

This project is for Lao applicants seeking to pursue academic degrees in China, and the funding period is as follows:

Program Duration

Master's Students: 3 years (covering only master phase if Master-PhD integrated study).

Doctoral Students: 4 years

Students will complete coursework at Nanjing Agricultural University (NAU) during the first phase and **reside in Sanya Yazhou Bay Science and Technology City** during the second phase onward to conduct research, ensuring deep integration of industry, academy, and research.

IV. Funding Policy

- 1) **Tuition Waiver:** Full tuition coverage.
- 2) **Accommodation:** Accommodation arranged by the school/Institute is provided free of charge (standard double room).
- 3) **Monthly Stipend:** CNY 3,000 per month for master students; CNY 3,500 per month for doctoral students.
- 4) **Comprehensive Medical Insurance:** Please visit <http://www.csc.edu.cn/studyinchina> or <http://www.campuschina.org> and refer to Comprehensive Insurance & Protection Scheme for Foreigners Staying in China for insurance policy.
- 5) **International Travel Expenses:** Borne by the applicant.
- 6) **Domestic Travel Allowance:** The maximum reimbursable amount for round-trip travel between NAU campus and Sanya is RMB 2,400 per academic year. The academic year is defined as September 1st of the current year to August 31st of the following year and cannot be accumulated across academic years; each academic year will be calculated independently.
- 7) **Scholarship Review:** The scholarship recipients' performance will be reviewed once a year, and only after passing the review can the next year's funding be continued.
- 8) **Notes:** Students registering before the 15th of the month (inclusive) receive full stipend for that month; after the 15th, half stipend. Those who fail to register within TWO months will automatically forfeit their scholarship.

Students should strictly abide by the regulations of the University. For students who leave China during the school holidays, the monthly stipend will be paid as usual. However, if

personal leave exceeds 15 days in one month, or 15 consecutive days outside the official holiday period, the monthly stipend will be deducted accordingly. For students who leave China for no more than 15 days for academic activities that have been approved by the university, the living expenses will be paid after their return. If the leaving period exceeds 15 days, the stipend will be suspended.

V. Application Eligibility

- 1) **Nationality:** Applicants must be Lao citizens and possess valid identification documents.
- 2) **Application Status:** Apply from abroad or be an outstanding graduate from a Chinese university with institutional recommendation.

- 3) **Academic Background:**

Master's applicants: Bachelor's degree or equivalent of related majors.

Doctoral applicants: Master's degree or equivalent of related majors.

- 4) **Academic Excellence:** The applicant must have excellent academic performance, and meet the requirements of the applied major.
- 5) **Health & Age:** Physically and mentally healthy. Age limit: ≤ 35 for master's applicants; ≤ 40 for doctoral applicants.
- 6) **Language Proficiency:**
 - **Chinese:** It is mandatory to acquire a valid certificate of HSK Level 5(or above); or have obtained a degree from a Chinese university where Chinese was used as the language of instruction.
 - **English:** Certificate of IELTS ≥ 6 or TOEFL ≥ 80 (TOEFL Mybest Scores is accepted, university DI code:C702, TOEFL Essentials are accepted.) (or); if the applicant cannot provide certificate of standardized English test, he/she

should provide relevant proof of English teaching in the previous stage of degree study.

- 7) **Material Requirements:** Applicants must submit complete materials. Uploaded supporting documents must be clear, authentic, and valid. It is recommended that applicants use professional equipment to scan the relevant documents. Applicants shall bear the consequences of any unclear or illegible documents uploaded.
- During the application process, applicants should closely monitor the system notifications and contact email. Any consequences arising from the applicant's failure to submit materials as required in a timely manner will be the applicant's responsibility.
- 8) **Long-term Residency Commitment:** After completing the required course credits at NAU, applicants must be able to reside in Sanya Yazhou Bay for extended research and academic activities.
- 9) **Other Scholarships:** In principle, students are limited to applying for one scholarship only.
- Should a student wish to apply for additional scholarships, a written explanation must be submitted to the university prior to application. Application for other scholarships may proceed only upon review and approval.
- Students who apply for other scholarships without prior authorization will have their eligibility for this scholarship program revoked.

VII. Application Procedure

- Step 1.** Find a suitable degree program.
- Step 2.** Find a relevant supervisor (see attachment 3) to provide provisional acceptance letter (see attachment 5).
- Step 3. Prepare application documents. *Please refer to V. Application Eligibility and VI. Documents Required .**
- Step 4.** Register and apply in NAU university application system: <https://njau.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx> (Category: Sino-Lao Modern Agricultural Industry Chain High-Caliber Talent Cultivation Program)
- Step 5.** Pay application fee: **CNY 500** or **USD 80**. Include name and passport number in the bank transfer, and email the receipt on the same day or the next day

to admission@njau.edu.cn. Non-refundable.

- Step 6.** Monitor the application system and email for updates, interviews, or additional requests.
